These holdings comprise the following percentages of the Fund's total net assets as of 31 Jan 2025: Aon PLC 1.8%; Citigroup Inc 4.3%; Everest Group Ltd 1.7%; Harley-Davidson Inc 1.3%; Samsung Electronics Co Ltd 2.9%; Southwest Airlines Co 1.7%. Securities mentioned that are not listed here or as a Top 10 Holding are no longer held in the portfolio as of the period end. The portfolio managers' views and portfolio holdings are subject to change and the Fund disclaims any obligation to advise investors of such changes.
